FERRIC MALTOL hard capsules (Feraccru®) for iron deficiency in adults

G R E Y

The Pan Mersey Area Prescribing Committee does not currently recommend the prescribing of FERRIC MALTOL hard capsules (Feraccru®) for the treatment of iron deficiency in adults

Ferric maltol (Feraccru[®]) is an iron trivalent, oral preparation, and has recently been granted a license extension and is now indicated for the treatment of iron deficiency in adults.¹

This recommendation will be reviewed if a formal application for use is received and prioritised for in year review.

In the meantime, clinicians should continue to follow local and national guidance for the treatment of iron deficiency anaemia:

- > Pan Mersey APC formulary chapter 9.1.1.1 Oral iron
