MOMETASONE / OLOPATADINE nasal spray (Ryaltris®) for allergic rhinitis

The Pan Mersey Area Prescribing Committee does not currently recommend the prescribing of MOMETASONE / OLOPATADINE nasal spray (Ryaltris[®]) for allergic rhinitis.

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Mometasone / olopatadine nasal spray (Ryaltris[®]) is indicated in adults and adolescents 12 years of age and older for the treatment of moderate to severe nasal symptoms associated with allergic rhinitis.^[1]

This recommendation will be reviewed if a formal application for use is received and prioritised for in-year review.

In the meantime, treatment of allergic rhinitis should continue to follow national guidance, local pathways, and local formulary choices.
